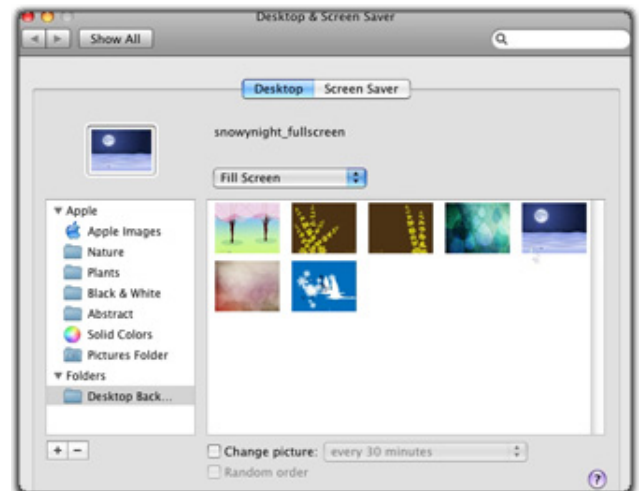
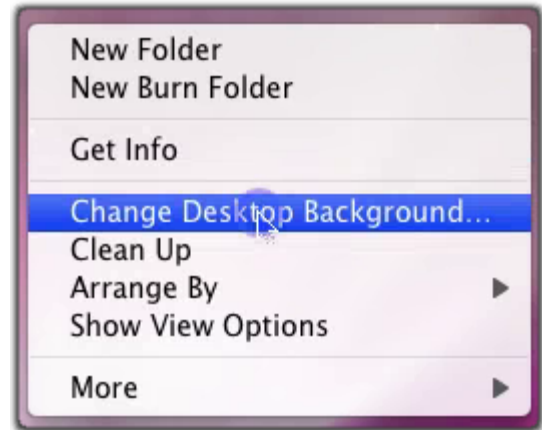


How to Change the Wallpaper in Mac OS X

1. Right click the desktop.
2. Choose Change Desktop Background from the context menu.
3. If the wallpaper image you wish to use isn't displayed in the list, click the plus sign below the list of folders on the left.
4. Browse for the folder containing the desired wallpaper images.
5. Click Choose at the bottom of the browse panel.
6. Select your chosen folder from the list on the left.
7. Select your desired wallpaper image from the thumbnails presented on the right.
8. If you choose, you may select multiple pictures and set an interval for them to cycle.



Your changes will immediately take effect, you may quit System Preferences. It's that easy
